

Carportable FAQs

1. What kind of vehicles does the Carportable cover?

- The Carportable has been designed to cover the average Australian car, small, medium or large. It can also be used to cover small boats trailers or jet skis etc. It has 4 aluminium tyre plates that can be adjusted by 180° to suit the wheelbase of all cars.

2. What type of surfaces can the Carportable be used on?

- The Carportable can be erected on any flat, level, hard surface as the car wheels stand on the 4 plates, and secure it against strong winds etc.

3. How long does it take to set up?

- It can be erected in approx 10 to 12 minutes and 8 – 9 minutes to dismantle.

4. What are the dimensions of the Carportable?

- The Carportable is 5.5m long, 2.0m high (at centre), and can be adjusted between 2.4m to 3.0 m wide. When retracted the end opening is approx 1.9m high.

5. Is the Carportable weather proof?

- The Carportable is waterproof and can withstand winds up to 50kph (or more when following the instruction manual). As no part of the cover or frame touches the vehicle (when erected correctly) it will protect against average hail, by acting as a trampoline but it is not guaranteed to protect against all hail.

6. What materials does the Carportable use?

- The Carportable's base and frame are all aluminium (rust free), the cover is nylon polyester with waterproof PU coating, UV50+ coating and is Ripstop. The black connectors are industrial quality nylon.

7. How long is delivery?

- Delivery will be within 6 - 8 weeks of order.

8. Can the Carportable be constructed permanently?

- Although it was created to be a temporary cover, it can be used for semi permanent use.

9. Can I purchase lost parts?

- It is of modular design so that all parts are replaceable, and can be purchased individually if required.
